Reflective Questions

“I have not come to call the righteous to repentance but sinners.”

- Luke 6:32

1. Have you tried to make sure that people don't see your brokenness or sinfulness? Have you ever tried to put on a facade in order to not show others that you are suffering, struggling or spiritually wounded? If so, why?
2. Tim spoke about sinful people like Zacchaeus, the woman at the well and Levi. Each of them had an experience where they, in Tim's words, “run towards Jesus”. They are compelled to go to him despite their sins. Is there an occasion in your life where you have, “run toward” Jesus despite sins that were weighing you down?
3. On the other hand, have you ever stayed away from God or prayer when you've fallen into sin? If so, why was that?
4. Sometimes, it's easy to struggle to repent because we are so afraid of showing God our sinfulness. When we look at our sin we are tempted to despair. Do not despair, this Lent, take time to do a good confession because God doesn't want you to despair, He wants your conversion and your trust in Him.
