Jesus Wants Our Conversion, Not Our Death with Pete Burak

Reflective Questions

“After this he went out and saw a tax collector named Levi sitting at the customs post. He said to him, ‘Follow me.’ And leaving everything behind, he got up and followed him.” Lk. 5:27-28

1. Pete describes “conversion moments” as those instances in the life of a Christian where we first encounter Jesus in a dramatic and personal way. Have you had a conversion moment like this in your life? If so, how did it impact you?
2. The story of Jesus calling St. Matthew gives us an example of how we should respond when we encounter Jesus in such a way. How have you responded to Christ’s call in your life? How can you respond more deeply to His call in your life?
3. St. Matthew responded to Jesus’ call by rising up, leaving everything behind, and following Him. But he also immediately began to share Jesus with his friends, just like we should. How can you strive to share Jesus with others in your life?
4. Jesus came for all men, as a Divine Physician for those who are spiritually sick. In what ways are you in need of the Divine Physician in your life?
