Reflective Questions

“All scripture is inspired by God and is useful for teaching, for refutation, for correction, and for training in righteousness,”

2 Tim. 3:16.

1. Father Ricardo describes an easy method of Lectio Divina and guides us through the practice with the Scripture passage about the woman caught in adultery. After reading the passage, what elements of the passage stand out to you as things you can reflect on?
2. The next step of Lectio Divina is to relate. Fr. Ricardo shares that one might relate to God about their dignity as a child of God, or about the importance of purity in their lives. What can you relate to God about from your reflections on this passage?
3. The third step of Lectio Divina is to rest with God. What does it feel like to rest with God after relating to Him in this way?
4. The last step of this method of Lectio Divina is to resolve. What resolutions might God be calling you to make, in light of this passage?
